Help is Available

If you need help repairing your home from damage caused by Hurricane Matthew, the state of North Carolina may be able to assist you by providing a housing recovery grant. Go to rebuild.nc.gov/apply for more information.

Step 1 Schedule an Appointment

To apply for a Hurricane Matthew housing recovery grant, you must schedule an appointment and meet with an application specialist. Your application specialist will help you walk through the full application. This visit may take up to two hours.

Apply as soon as possible. An application center is now open in Wayne County. Schedule your appointment by calling:
