All recipe contest times will be at 1pm.

Recipe Contest Rules:

- Contests are open to all ages.
- Entries will be received from 1pm to 1:30pm.
- Judging will begin at 1:30pm.
- Recipe must include at least 1 cup of the featured ingredient.
- Contestants must be present during the contest.
- Contestants may enter more than one recipe, but only one recipe can win.
- Entries must be prepared at home and presented at the market ready for judging.
- Entry will need to serve 3 to 4 judges.
- Entries must be homemade.
- Entries may be brought in any type of container (preferably disposable); it is not the responsibility of the farmers market to return any dishes.
- Recipe must be submitted with entry.
- Entries maybe served to the audience after judging and announcement of winner.
- The 1st place winner's recipe and picture will be published in local media outlets.
- Entries will be judged on the following: Taste, Use of featured ingredient, Appearance, and Texture.
