1. The Wayne County Inspections Department will be limiting public access starting Wednesday, March 25th, 2020 at 8am due to continued impacts of COVID-19. Permit submittals can also be left at a designated area outside of the lobby area.
3. Building plans can be mailed to the attention of Wayne County Building Inspections, PO Box 227, Goldsboro NC 27533. Plan submittals can also be left at a designated area outside of the lobby area.
4. Payment of fees can be made by phone by calling the department directly at 919-731-1169 or by check mailed to the attention of Wayne County Building Inspections, PO Box 227, Goldsboro NC 27533.
5. Requests for inspections can be submitted by email to kathie.fields@waynegov.com or tammy.wilson@waynegov.com or by phone to 919-731-1169. Inspections of unoccupied structures may be limited and staff asks that only the inspector be allowed in the building during the inspection. There will be no inspections of occupied structures except for emergency situations.
6. Anyone wishing to speak directly with an inspector is asked to call the office before 9am each morning or after 4pm each afternoon as opposed to in-person visits.
